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Polypharmacy / Psychotropic / Antibiotic usage in Aged Care

It is very important to understand that as health care providers we always consider and uphold to non-pharmacologic management prior to pharmacologic management. Aged Care Quality and Safety Commission are making sure that the health care professionals have exhausted all the efforts prior to eventually prescribing medication.

- Quality of life of the resident Vs. Prolong the life of the residents. Each medication has risks and benefit this is what needs to be considered when prescribing medication.
- Tolerance to medication can increase when being introduced with medication for example pain relievers and sleeping tablets.
- Inappropriate use of antibiotic can eventually lead to resistance where in the long run no antibiotic will be able to address the bacterial infection.
- Prior to prescribing antibiotic it is very important to attend to the following:
 - -Obtaining urine from resident and sending it to pathologist to confirm infection.
 - -Wound swab from resident wound to attend to culture and sensitivity to confirm what is the type of infection and what antibiotic can be given which the infection will respond to.
 - -Obtaining PCR or nasal swab to confirm if the resident has viral infection.


