- support people living with dementia

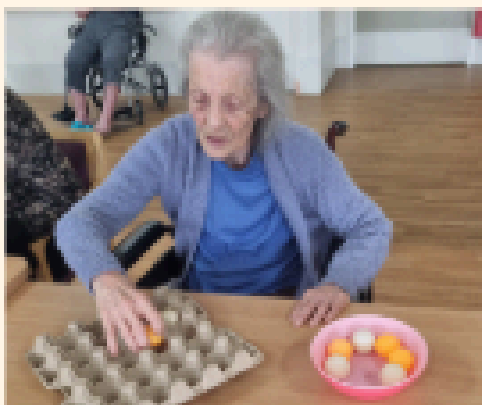
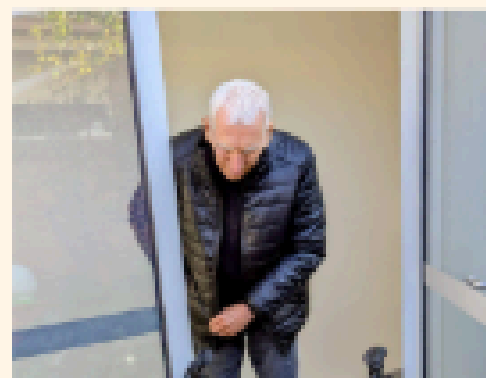
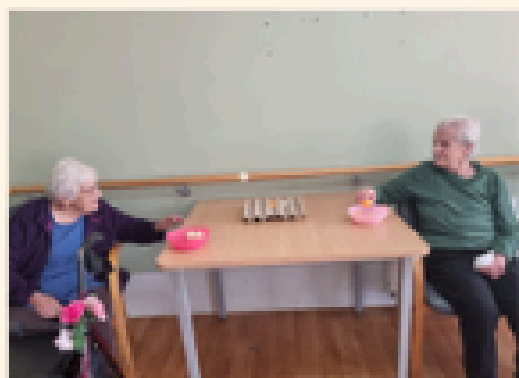
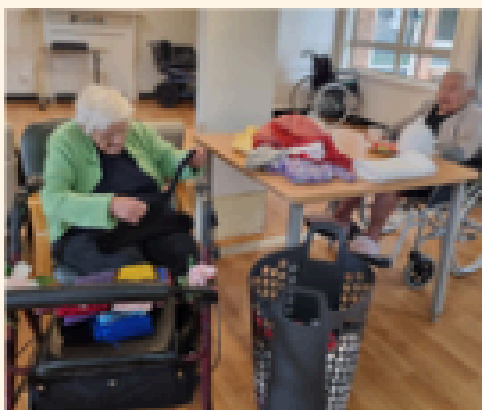
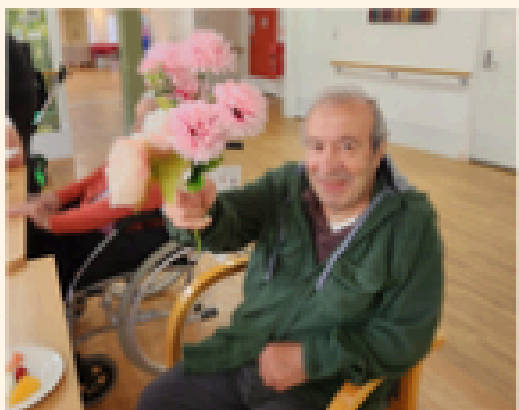

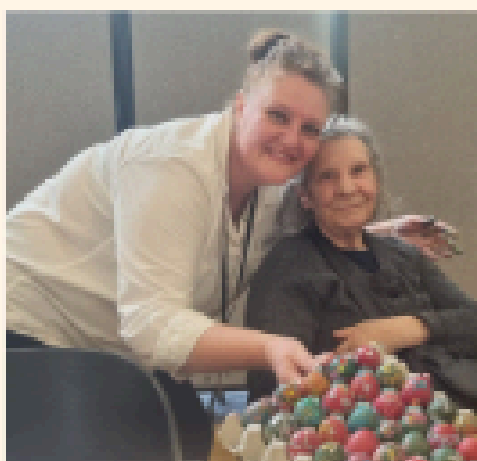
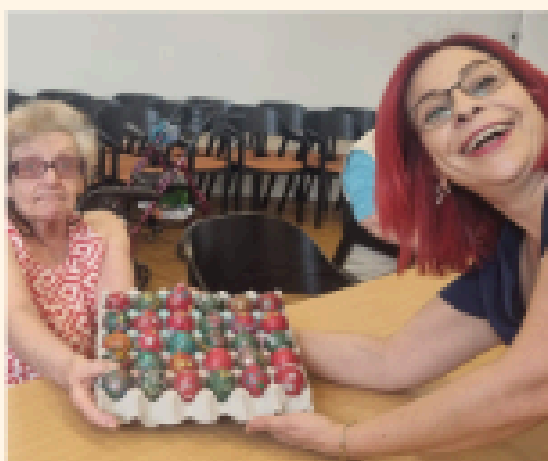
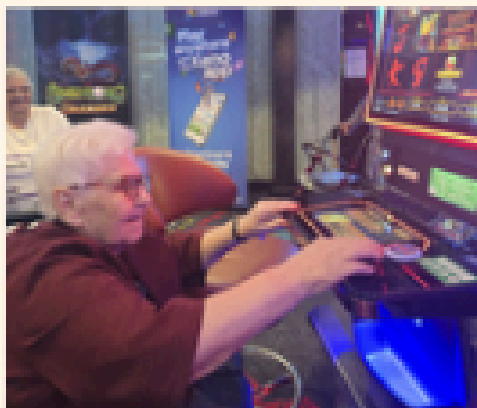
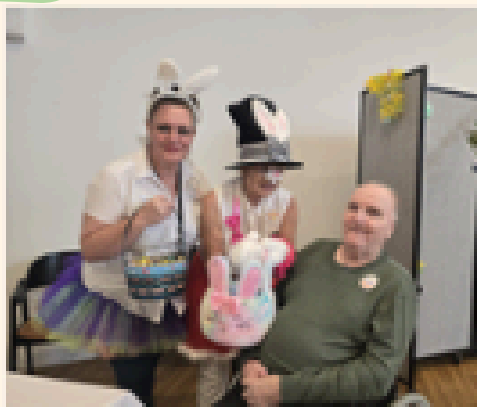
Maja Hrudka

Maja Hrudka residents had plenty of opportunities to spend time with the animals at the facility or catch up with the Men's Shed in the garden.



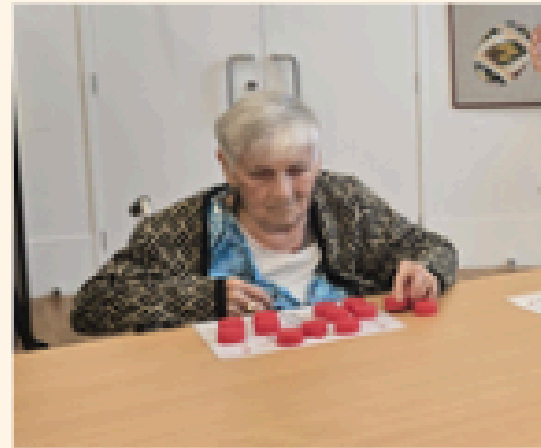
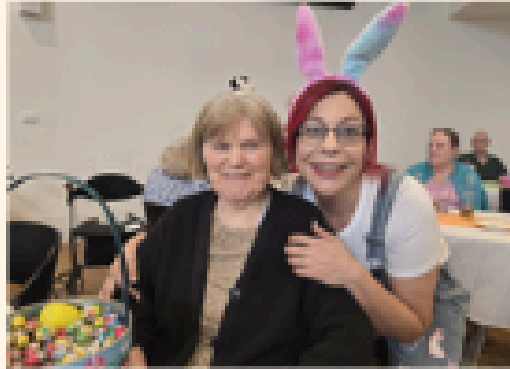
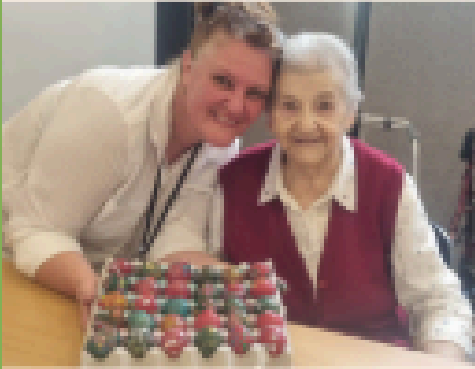

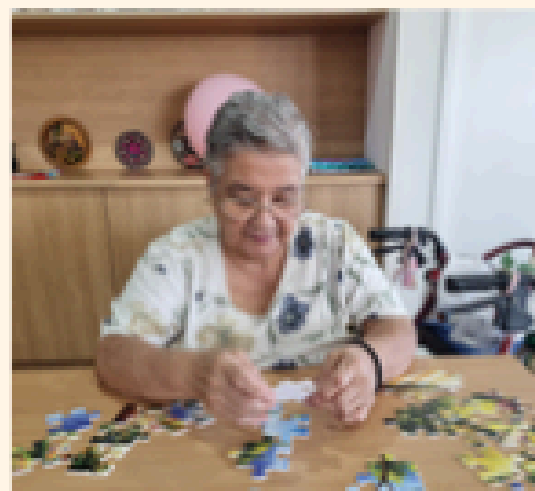
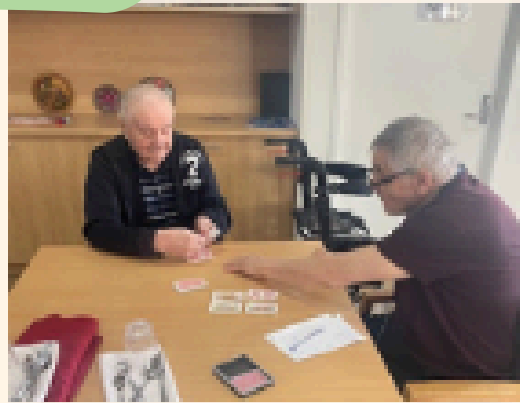
Konvalyia
